Greetings QCA Families:

At our Back-To-School Night, I mentioned our efforts to launch a new concept this year called *"The QCA Way".* Our hope is that this simple phrase will identify a set of value-based standards that encapsulate our expectations for student behavior. It's a phrase that can been used as positive reinforcement for excellent behavior choices and, conversely, as a relevant and realistic reminder when students veer "off-path". *"The QCA WAY"* will hopefully serve as a lighthouse beacon, guiding the choices our students make. Teachers and students weighed in with their input and the combined ideas helped us create the set of values that identify *"The QCA Way"*, which include: *Respect, Kindness, School Pride, Empathy, Teamwork, Acceptance and always doing your best work.* I think it's a pretty impressive list of standards to strive to uphold.

As the principal, I am proud of our students for the way they typically treat one another with respect and kindness and empathy. However, as in every school, children do not always uphold these expected behaviors. At QCA, we do not tolerate meanness and unkindness, or in more serious cases, harassment or bullying-behavior. With that in mind, we want to remind all parents and children how important it is to report any concerns about any observed negative behaviors to a teacher or staff member, so that we can do the necessary investigation to determine the appropriate next steps. If you have any concerns, I encourage you to review the QCA Student Handbook section which addresses Bullying, including a copy of the Bullying Form, which when completed, begins the process of investigation. Ideally and most often, once a situation is identified and properly addressed, the negative behavior changes and the students are able to coexist peacefully and without conflict.

"The QCA Way" provides a proactive roadmap for us all to be our best selves and to represent our school with pride, dignity and honor. Our prayer is that together, we stay on the right path and build a school that is reflective of God's love and grace.
