AFTER-SCHOOL/EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM:

Hello QCA Families! We are looking forward to a great year at **Extended Day!** The program will begin on Monday, September 9, 2024. The hours are 2:00-6:00 for preschool and K1 and 2:15-6:00 for K2 through Grade 8. On half days the program ends at 2:30.

Important: If you have NOT registered yet the 2024-2025 school year, you must do so asap! Even if you participated last year, you MUST re-register to participate this year! It's simple... just go on the school website (<u>www.quincycatholicacademy.org</u>) and click on the Program Tab for Extended Day.

Extended Day is a great way for your child to have some time with friends in a relaxed environment after school. The typical schedule for the students is as follows: snack and free time, homework (staff can provide assistance), activity time (gym, playground, school yard, etc). We have a strict No Electronics policy at Extended Day. Students will not be permitted to use phones, tablets, etc. unless they are for specific homework assignments (this will be monitored). We kindly ask that all families send students with a snack and water. These items will not be provided by the school.

Beginning in October we will be switching to an online timeclock. Each family will receive a student number that will be used to manually clock out your child/children from the program. If you do not clock out, you will be billed for the entire day. The cost is \$8.50 per hour and is billed by the hour. Please plan accordingly. Any family arriving after 6:00 on full days or 2:30 on half days will be billed one dollar per minute.

If you happen to arrive after 7:45 a.m. for K2-Grade 8 or after 8:15 a.m. for the Early Childhood, please go to the front main door for admittance.

BAND & INSTRUMENT LESSONS



We have a fantastic band program here at QCA for all students in grades 1 - 8! 1st & 2nd graders may learn the violin only. 3rd - 8th graders may learn any band instrument (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, drums) or violin.

Group lessons take place on Tuesdays after school under the direction of Mrs. Jennifer Hawes. All students (beginners included) will have an opportunity to perform in a Spring concert and experienced students will have the opportunity to also perform in the Christmas concert, at Faneuil Hall in Boston and may be selected to participate in the Massachusetts Honor Band. No experience in necessary to take lessons - we teach students of all experience levels.
